

Summer School on Nuclear Decommissioning and Waste Management

8-12 July 2019 in Ispra, Italy

On 8-12 July 2019, the European Commission Joint Research Centre (JRC) in Ispra, Italy, is hosting [a 5-day training](#) on nuclear decommissioning and waste management ([ELINDER](#) training programme). The course also includes visits to the nuclear installations in Ispra and practical illustrative case studies.

The ‘Decommissioning Summer School’ is open to graduate students in the field of engineering, science and technology including environmental science, sustainability, chemistry, biology, geology, who have not yet a professional activity. The JRC supports courses and accommodation. Travel costs may be subject to partial reimbursement.

The minimum required education level is by default for all courses European Qualifications Framework (EQF) level 6, corresponding to a Bachelor Degree or equivalent.
