Objectives

There are no exciting any academic educational programs in the field of Human Nutrition and Dietetics in Armenia and we have a huge gap in this field and big demand in the labour market. Yerevan State Medical University is highly interested and is planning to develop and introduce a relevant master program (MA) on Human Nutrition and Dietetics in the faculty (department) of Public Health for students with medical background. To succeed in this goal we are looking for European HEI professional support to design a high quality and competitive MA program. It is worth mentioning that some actions have already been taken in YSMU. We successfully completed one bilateral mobility program with Copenhagen University NEXS department in the field of human Nutrition teaching and training.
